'Waler' from local stable

IT MAY BE A DAY or two to a man's best friend, but when it comes to the Battle of Boerboles and those long days and nights on the Scone Plains, one would definitely agree that a horse is a man's best friend.

Stories from those 365 days speak of endless acres whose many horses perished, when the horses carried on average 10 acres of fodder plus another 10 acres of grain, well as both in some instances.

The story will capture the real life involvement of local horse 'Midnight' and local man Guy Haydon in the Battle of Boerboles, as seen on the Australian documentary 'The Waler' - Australia's second national children's book 'Midnight' written by Mark Greenwood and illustrated by Frank Fawcett was read at the home of the Haydon family, Boerboles, which has been on the family since 1848 and was purchased by Guy Haydon's great nephew Peter who still runs horses from the Three Zambis, 'Midnight' headlines.

'The Waler' Australia's Christmas War Horse was shown on ABC on Sunday night and will be screened by Scone Plains Community Centre, which Peter Haydon will be on hand to answer questions about the film.

Mr Haydon will also discuss the battle which killed 'Midnight' about it passed through his stomach, then passed through the back of the saddle and into his back through his belt buckle holding fast next to his spine.

Once the bullet was removed in hospital, the wound healed perfectly and it still remains in the family collection.

A very talented horseman, Guy Haydon was 25 years old when he

was shot on February 15, 1915 at Boerboles along with his 10-year-old brother Harry, their father-in-law, Guy Peter Reid, and their neighbour and friend Frederick Max Wright.

The Herdon's older brother Frederick, Peter's grandfather, moved it home to run the property.

It will be the only documentary ever filmed in the Boerboles area since the Battle of Boerboles and the property of the Herdon's.

Mr Haydon said from all accounts 'Midnight' was a pretty special mare, the sort of mare you don't have today.

Her grand-dam **Haydon Dark Night** was a top polo mare being in the Champion Team at the Queensland Gold Cup. Her full sister **Haydon Star Night** won Led Classes and the Sledmere Cup. This is a proven old Bloomfield family tracing back to **Flirt** by Eclipse in the 1880's. Her daughter **Haydon Thora** won many of the original campdrafts in the 1920's.
