



Maximus

Maximus was started at polo proving a lovely horse to ride, stick & ball and play. However, he got kicked during chukkas and was retired.

His full sister **Tutu** plays very well, she won a BPP, was in the winning 2015 Hector King Team and is Fiola's best horse. His full brother **General** and his half-brother the stallion **Gold Dust** played very well overseas. Cole Aguirre selected **General** when he was given the pick of the horses for his 21st birthday and was his best horse to play overseas.

His dam was the highly rated TB international polo mare **U2** who started playing in Australia before excelling in England and Spain. She was a compact chestnut TB mare 15.1 hh with a star and small strip. She had a lovely head and took to polo as a real natural. High goal Los Tamaros Patron Bob Aguirre rated her as one of his best. It was decided her feats playing overseas warranted her return to Australia to be used as a broodmare. She was a good type, a natural and just so easy to play. Unfortunately, the premature death of her previous owner meant the details of her TB pedigree were not passed on.

His sire **Timorpolo Patton** is out of the top Never In Doubt TB mare **Mirawala**, who played all levels right through to the Ellerston 40 Goal when played by Gonzalo Pieres, the world's top 10 goal player at the time. The remarkable story of **Mirawala** starts when she was purchased in the paddock from Never in Doubt's owner Jack Johnston as an un-ridden nine year old. Six months after being started she won her first BPP award! Started by well known horseman Greg Bennett he recalls she took to stick and balling "like a duck to water". He was blown away by how soft and easy she was, describing her as a "feak" and for him "the standout of a life time".

Patton has proved a genuine sire of many good polo horses and is the sire of top Ellerston overseas mares **Tweetie** from Kylie, dam of BPP at Ellerston **Canary** and **Posh** played by Charlie Hanbury in the Queens Cup 2009-2012, Gold Cup 2009-2011, Deauville Gold Cup 2010 and then the 2013 US Open. She has produced many playing progeny for the Hanburys. In 1997 he also produced at Ellerston the very good horses **Limbo, Oak, Pimms, Spider, Jillian, Pine, Henry, Rely, Halo, Snip, Messenger, China, Padre, JD, Kenny** and **Suzerain**.

At Timor, he sired a multitude of very good horses including; **Stella** BPP 2017 Silver Cup, **Naomi** won a BPP winning the Hector King, **Vegas** a BBP winner, **Julia** BPP at Alsace 2017, **Tutu, General, Charlize, Hawaii, Carrera, Elle, Verona**, the sires **Maximus, Mr Timor, Bellagio, Augustus, Julius**, etc.

Littlewood Montego (Monty)

Patton is from the **Panzer**, Hall of Fame sire line and by top international polo sire **Littlewood Montego** (“Monty”) used extensively at Ellerston. He is the sire of the remarkable polo horses **Claret, Music, Champagne, Casa, Jamaica, Actress, Armanda, Retail, Jackpot, Punch, Disco, Burgundy, Canoe, Ferry, Samoa, Nana, Saint, Soprano, Polka**, etc. He has had many successful sire sons’ including **Churchill, Patton, Cuba, Revenue, Gillette, Spartacus**, etc. Monty’s dam **Gamma** and her two full sisters were very good polo mares. Her dam **Gissa** was a good Nationals polocrosse mare and rated by her owner as the fastest horse her ever played. This speed she got from her mother **Minker** who won races and played top polocrosse being by Basalt by Star Kingdom. Gamma’s sire Hill was by the renowned sire Terlings Deo Juvante.





Never In Doubt sired the top polo mares **Kylie, Mirawala** and **Easy Going-IM HSH** who have all had an immense influence on polo horses worldwide, including his son **Haydon Never Doubt** who excelled as a sire. Other good mares included **Dusk, Honeymoon** and **Sunrise** dam of **Two Moons** and **Mugnaini** dam Sledmere Cup winner **Romanella**.

NEVER IN DOUBT


Towards the end of his career, NEVER IN DOUBT had the distinction of being the last sire son of the champion (unarranged) sire, Navaro (caly - 1835) left alive in the world. You would have expected that the Jack Johnson stallion would have been inundated with mares, being by such an illustrious sire and out of a Standard mare but amazingly, nothing could have been further from the truth. Very lightly used by thoroughbred breeders he only produced in his lifetime 148 runners for 68 winners.



In England NEVER IN DOUBT showed 10 times as much for his sire. He first ran one year in 1861 at 4 years old he was imported to Australia by 40 years of age. He was never used in a stud.

"I remember in 1911," said old John Thompson (aged 80) "I saw a pair of 'Never in Doubt' colts in the paddock at the Country Club for a number of years and it was then I acquired a pair of NEVER IN DOUBT in that year that was soon by Jack Johnson. I gave them to my son and Jack's 2. The girl stayed for a year."

Maximus's first foals were born in 2016. Haydon Horse Stud has 16 weanlings by him to register. 10 are brown fillies with light muzzles reminding us so much of the Never Doubt/Never In Doubt progeny. These fillies are like "peas in a pod", great types with great temperaments. At least 3 colts show sire potential.

They have all handled up very well to lead, tie up, load, lie down, been sat on, had their feet done, drenched and vaccinated.
