'Waler' from local stable

IT'S BY A NAME AS OLD AS TIME it might seem distant, but when it comes to the Battle of Beersheba and those brave men who fought on the Sinai Front, one would definitely agree that a horse is a man's best friend.

From those 800 brave soldiers who fought the battle, many horses perished, when the horses carried an average 10 stone of soldier plus saddle, ammunition, sword, rifle and clothes, including, even, their own food, with rations of grain, will be told in Beersheba tomorrow evening.

The story will recount the real life involvement of local horse 'Midnight' and how they were used in the Battle of Beersheba, as seen on the Australian documentary 'The Waler', Australia's Great War. It is a story of a horse named 'Midnight' which was bred, owned and illustrated by Frank Foster, owner of 'The Waler' stud, 'Midnight' was bred at the home of Mr. Haydon, family 'Bismarck' which has been in the family since 1812 and is now owned by Guy Haydon, great nephew of Frank Foster who bred the horse.

'Midnight' was bred at 'The Waler' stud, which was owned by Frank Foster who was also an A.P.C. on Sunday night and will be entered by Beersheba tomorrow evening, when Peter Haydon will be on hand to answer questions about the horse.

Mr. Haydon will also observe the battle which 'Midnight' was at present through the back of the saddle, and roll and through Guy's feet because that was to his name.

Since the battle was fought in 1915, the world has to his name and it will remain in the family forever.

A very talented horseman, Guy Haydon was 25 years old when he

was based on February 15, 1915 at Beersheba, along with his 10-year-old brother, Peter, their future partner in law, Fred Foster, and their partner and friend, Peter's brother, Fred.

The horse's older brother, Fred, was a competitor of horses to run the property.

The experience that followed are covered in the story that will be told in Beersheba tomorrow evening.

The film was the only documentary shot in the Beersheba area and was shot in the area of Beersheba and the Haydon's Sports Creek property.

Mr. Haydon said: "It was a pretty special mare, the sort of mare you don't see today."

"We still have those same bloodlines today as we have 10 generations of the mare lines that have lived right through."

Mr. Haydon encouraged people to go along to the event tomorrow and learn all about the local horse.

Her grand-dam **Haydon Dark Night** was a top polo mare being in the Champion Team at the Queensland Gold Cup. Her full sister **Haydon Star Night** won Led Classes and the Sledmere Cup. This is a proven old Bloomfield family tracing back to **Flirt** by Eclipse in the 1880's. Her daughter **Haydon Thora** won many of the original campdrafts in the 1920's.
