Haydon No Doubt was started in polo, was good to play and then used as a broodmare, after the international exploits of her three-quarter sister Haydon Spanish Jet. She has produced Haydon Faberge a standout filly by Ruski in 2019 and Haydon Campari by Ruski in 202. Haydon **Spanish Jet**, named after a gemstone which was fashionable was during the reign of Queen Victoria, was played in the winning Garangula team at Ellerston in March, 2013 by John Paul Clarkin before going overseas to win the 26 goal Westchester Cup Test Match in England, the US Open played by 9 goaler Facundo Sola and starred with him in Dubai. She has an enviable, strong polo pedigree combining, in her immediate generations, the champion polo sires Haydon Drawn, Rodeo Rush, Haydon Never Doubt and Austock Beranghi. She also combines the best of the two old Haydon Jewel and Thora families.

Grand-dam **Haydon Lavender Jewel** proved a good producing mare and her mother **Haydon Gaelic Gem** was a full-sister to **Haydon Quartz** who was Champion Horse at the Qld Polocrosse Championships in 1991 which was also won by her daughter **Haydon Festina**. Her dam line is from the renowned Haydon Jewel Family, tracing back to **Haydon Gem** who was Champion Polo Pony R.A.S in 1967, she was played by ten-goal player Bob Skene in 1962 and by HRH The Prince of Wales in 1966. Then back to **Haydon Topaz** who also competed at the R.A.S in 1937, going back to top mare **Haydon Countess** in the 1880's.

Sire: Ellerston Ruski

Ruski is from the renowned Norman **Pentaguad** sire line and from the family of Hall of Fame mare **Pinky**. His dam is the great Solar mare Cruiser and he is by the top sire Cavalier, Sheltie's full brother. His pedigree includes the famous mares Hall of Fame mares La Luna and Pinky, Dinghy, Cruiser, Sheltie and Blue with close relations Claret, Skiff, Spinnaker, Yacht and Clarity. He combines the two legendary mares La Luna, regarded as the greatest playing and producing mare in Argentina and similarly for Pinky in Australia. Ruski started well in young horse chukkas in 2016 with his first foals were born in 2018, inheriting his type and temperament.



In June 2018 – Ruski's mother **Cruiser** made a stunning UK debut, winning BPP in her first tournament. The prize was presented by the Queen to her 10-goal player Adolfo Cambiaso, after winning the Royal Windsor tournament. In a memorable play Adolfo turned the ball on her on the backline and then completely outran the whole team to score a stunning full length of the field goal. She just did everything at pace so easily. Adolfo Cambiaso then took her to Argentina to win the Argentine Open with his 40-goal team La Dolfina. The fact he actually played her in his string with the Cuartetera clones simply speaks volumes of what he thought of her. In 2019 her full brother Skiff won the same prize for BPP at same Royal Windsor tournament!
